Task 5. Listening Script.

There are four rooms *in* my house. There are two rooms *downstairs* and two rooms *upstairs*.

The *living room* and *kitchen* are *downstairs*. The *kitchen* is small. It is *on the left*. The *living room* is big. It is *on the right*.

In the *living room*, there are a red table and two green chairs *on the left*. There is a white shelf *behind* the table. The sofa is *on the right*. There is a beautiful picture *above* it.

In the *kitchen*, there are a blue fridge, a white stove, and a grey sink. There are dirty plates *in* the sink and a big pan *on* the stove. There is an orange kettle *next to* the sink.

Upstairs, the *bathroom* is *on the left* and the *bedroom* is *on the right*. The *bedroom* is bigger than the *bathroom*. The *bathroom* is the smallest room *in* the house.

In the bathroom, the bath is *on the left*. The sink is *next to* the bath. The toilet is *on the right*. There is a long mirror *above* the sink.

There are two beds *in* the *bedroom*. One is *on the left* and the other is *on the right*. The bed *on the left* is smaller than the bed *on the right*. There are purple and yellow pictures *above* the beds and a big brown wardrobe *between* them.

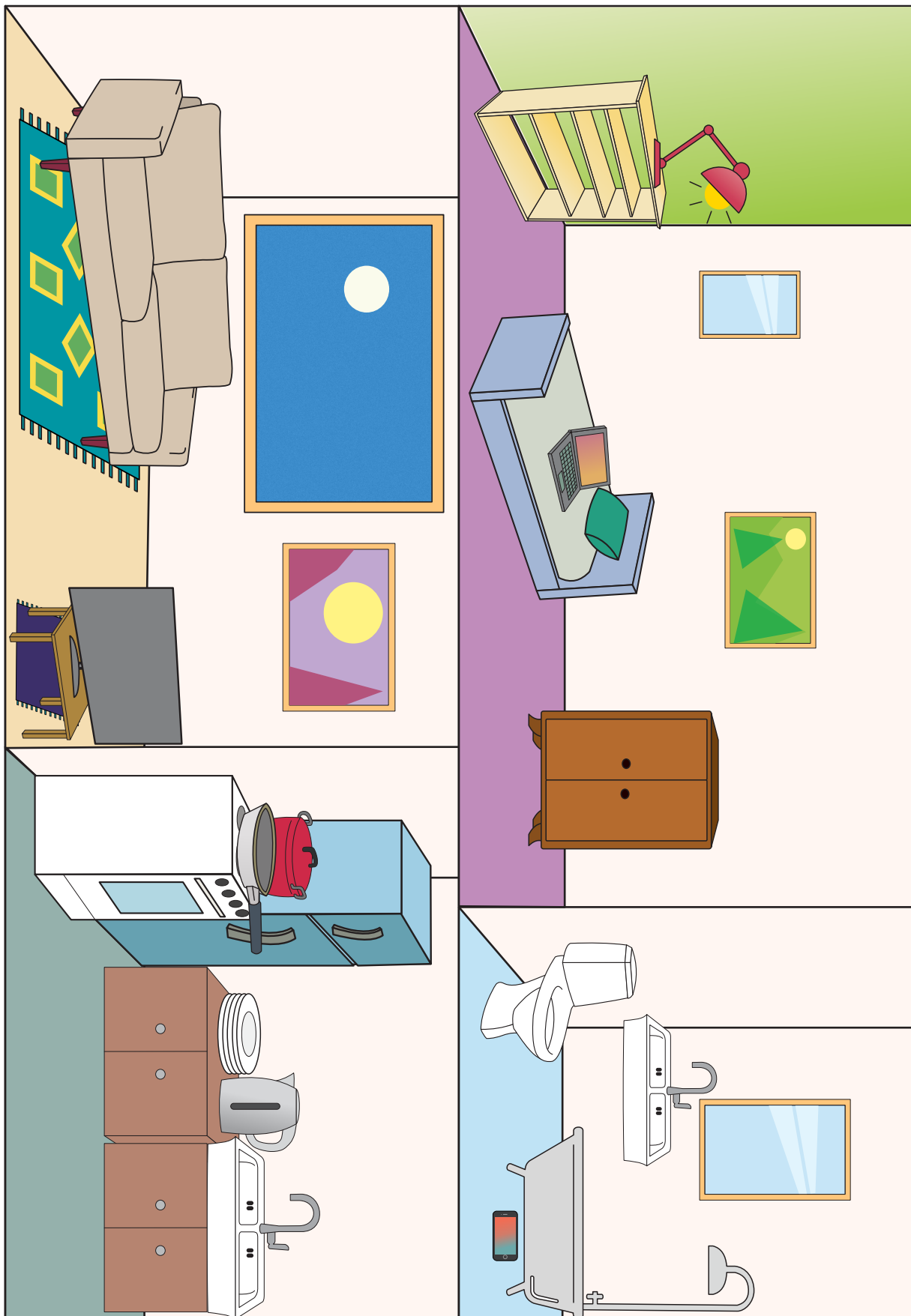
Task 8. Spot the differences.
