

# Using the Internet (B1)

## Teacher's notes

### Task 4. Listening script.

1) To *log in* to a computer, I *type* my *username* and my *password*.

Then, I click ‘*Log in*’.

2) After I *log in*, I connect to the *WiFi*. Without *Wifi*, I can’t use the *Internet*.

3) I check my *email* every day.

To check my *email*, I open the *browser*. In the *browser*, I type the *website address* into the *address bar*. Then I press ‘*Enter*’.

Then, I *log in* to my *email*. I type my *email address* and *password*. Then, I click ‘*Log in*’. My *email address* is “*Aisha\_1@gmail.com*”. I can’t tell you my *password* - it is a secret.

4) I often use Google to find pictures.

In the *browser*, I type ‘*www.google.com/images*’ in the *address bar* and press ‘*Enter*’.

Then, I *type* what I want to find into the *search bar* and click ‘*Search*’.

Sometimes I *download* pictures to my computer. I right-click the picture, then click ‘*Save*’.

5) I also like to watch videos. YouTube is my favourite *website*.

To go to YouTube, I *type* ‘*www.youtube.com*’ in the *address bar* and press ‘*Enter*’.

Then, I use the *search bar* to find videos. I watch videos about English, music, food, and sports.
